

DO YOU HAVE KNEE PAIN & TROUBLE SLEEPING?

PARTICIPANTS ARE NEEDED for a research study to evaluate a new, non-narcotic sleep medication in patients with arthritis of the knee.

Researchers at the **Johns Hopkins School of Medicine** are looking for volunteers to participate in a clinical trial examining the effects of a new sleeping medication used nightly for 3 months on: sleep, pain, and daytime symptoms

➤ **To participate in this study, you must be:**

Between the ages of 18-64

Have osteoarthritis of the knee for 5 years or less

Trouble sleeping for at least 6 months

(Insomnia does not have to be related to knee pain)



➤ **This study involves:**

1 Overnight sleep study

May include X - Rays of the knee

Sensory testing

All examinations, parking, & medication are provided at no cost.

➤ **Compensation up to \$150**
